Domestic Violence Advocate & Survivor In 2015, Emma, a young Irish woman and mother of 2 children, bravely broke the silence and posted a YouTube video about her Domestic Violence experience that became viral within hours - starting Emma's new life as an advocate for women. Since then, Emma has developed her skills as a fitness trainer and set up her own business; she is extremely passionate about health, fitness and lifestyle. She organises "Mind Over Matter", a roadshow that combines activities about healthy eating, fitness and mental well-being. Emma has become a voice for women experiencing violence, speaking at various conferences (Third World Women's Conference in The Netherlands, Safe Ireland Summit), doing TED Talks, radio interviews, and collaborating with events. She recently featured in the RTÉ documentary "Emma Murphy fights back". Emma's initiatives, website and blog continue to empower women on a daily basis.

The Goals of EMPROVE are Empowering survivors through the improvement of:

The Support of Domestic Violence Survivors:

Supporting capacity building of front-line staff through the development of training and resources.

The Ability to Recognise the Signs of Domestic Violence:

Organising special series of events for key stakeholders and police staff, medical workers etc. who should be able to recognise first signs of violence, even if the potential victim hasn't spoken about it openly – the FRA survey confirms that "only 14 % of women reported their most serious incident of intimate partner violence".

Networking:

Bringing services and stakeholders together to make informed referrals and build communication in the fight against domestic violence.

Policy Making:

On regional, national and transnational levels in regard of Domestic Violence prevention and intervention – as confirmed by the FRA director in 2014, change in the scope of laws and policies is needed.
