

## Digital Arts Dialogue 5th Project Newsletter NOVEMBER 2023



### What's New?

As we are approaching the final phase of the project, the partners are focusing on the multiplier and promotion events of DigiArts, to improve the reach and impact of the project and inform youth workers of the possibilities the project offers. Find out more about the events below.



### Spain, September - October 2023

The Spanish partner, Consultoría de Innovación Social, held two multiplier events, one in September and one in October 2023, informing about the project, its results, and impact. The events also included a practical activity part where all participants were invited to move and dance. The participants highlighted their appreciation for having practical examples and seeing the approach directly in action.

### France, October 2023

The multiplier event in France was held on 19th October 2023 in the training centre for youth workers ITS Pierre Bourdieu in Pau. Twenty participants attended the event during which the project, the manual and the e-learning platform were presented in detail. To make the experience interactive, two activities from the e-learning platform were demonstrated and attendees actively involved. There was time dedicated to present their ideas, as well as to provide feedback.



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### Bulgaria, November 2023

Happiness Academy organised a multiplier event on 26th October. More than 20 people attended the event. We presented the project and all its products. Within the event we tried out 2 activities from PR2 – “Music and Words” and “Find your Hobby”. The attendants were very interested in the project outputs and participated actively in the activities. Most of the participants shared in their feedback that they intend to take a closer look at the project outputs and also intend to use them in their future work.

As the outputs are very diverse they appealed to different target groups. For example the social workers were mainly interested in the restorative justice concept, which is pretty new for Bulgaria, while the participants with educational background were more interested in the activities, based on art and digital technology.



### Germany, October 2023

BUPNET held the German event on October 12th 2023. Due to the good weather the event was held outside. The event enabled the participants to engage directly with the project and to try out two of the activities developed, to discuss the development process, and get insight into the project and its results.



### Greece, October 2023

The Department of Theatre Studies of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens held their workshop on October 30th 2023 with 22 professionals from youth organisations with a presentation about the developed manual, as well as a practical exercise part on acting and group work.

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### Italy, October 2023



On 18 October, Liberitutti organised the Multiplier Event for our DiGiarts project at the Barriere di Milano - Bagni Pubblici Agliè neighbourhood centre.

Around twenty participants attended, most of whom were already working as educators, along with a few students training to become social workers and project managers from social cooperatives. What they all had in common was that they worked with young people. Often young people in difficulty.

The participants were particularly interested in the Manual, which gave them a better understanding of the concepts and values of reparative justice, as well as the practicalities of e-learning.

For them, using theatre and digital technology to work with young people is a real added value, particularly in terms of important concepts such as the fight against stereotypes and self-confidence.
