- Contribute to better access to digital and career development opportunities.

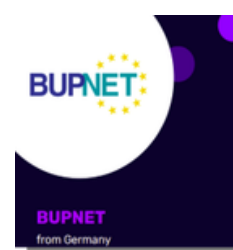
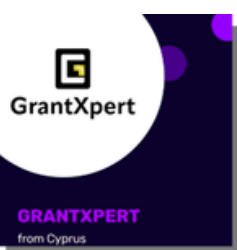

Palermo: Launching Collaboration and Shared Vision



On 7–8 May 2025, the TRANSFORM partnership met in Palermo, Italy, for the project's first in-person gathering. The meeting marked an important first step, offering partners the opportunity to move from proposal to practice and to begin building a shared direction for the project, active in 7 European countries. Across two days of discussion and exchange, the partnership laid the foundations for a collaborative and participated process shaped by dialogue, complementary expertise, and a common ambition to support more inclusive and resilient pathways in the labour market for both individuals and small and medium enterprises.



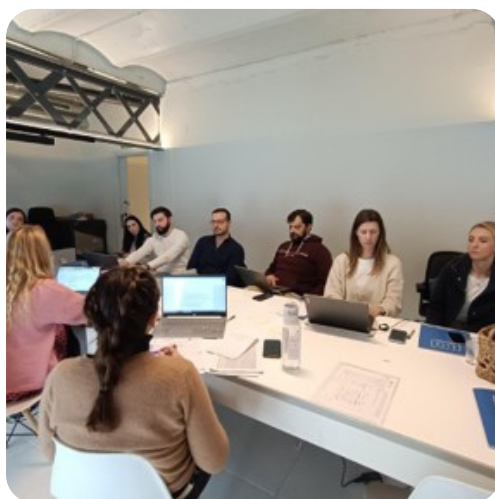

Girona: Building on Progress Together

On 28–29 January 2026, the TRANSFORM partnership met in Girona, Spain, for its second in-person project meeting hosted by Blue Room Innovation SL. If Palermo marked the beginning of a shared path, Girona represented a moment of consolidation: a chance to reflect on what had been achieved, examine the work still in progress, and shape the next steps together. The meeting created space for both review and perspective, allowing partners to address challenges, exchange insights, and maintain a strong collective focus on the project's wider aims. In doing so, it further strengthened the sense of cooperation at the heart of TRANSFORM and helped carry the project confidently into its next phase.

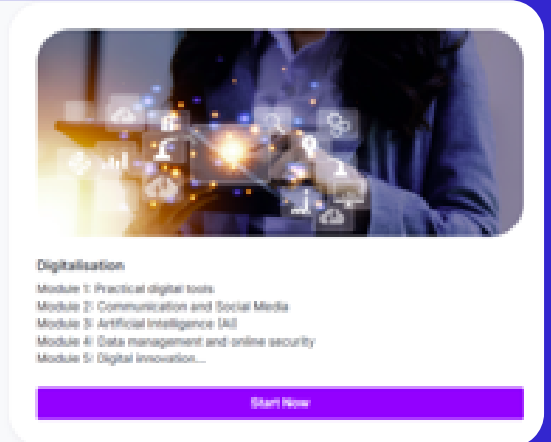
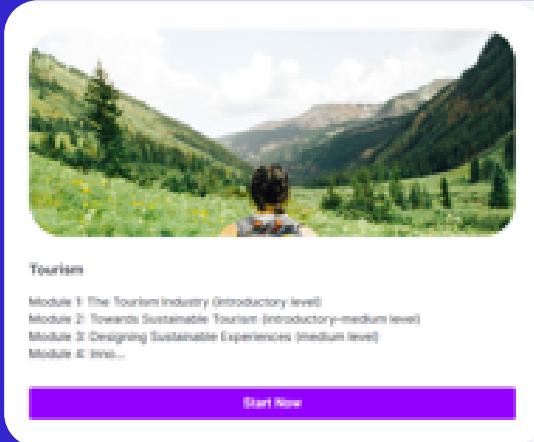
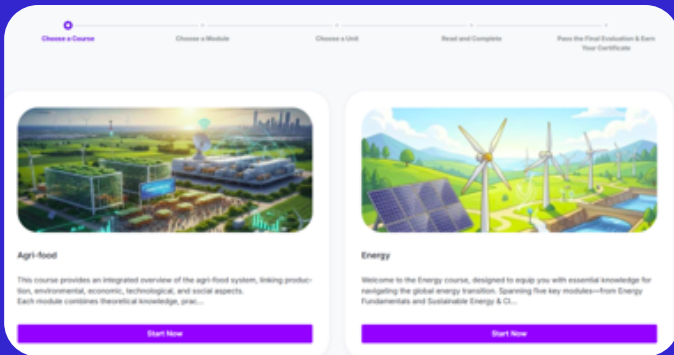

Transform Info Days



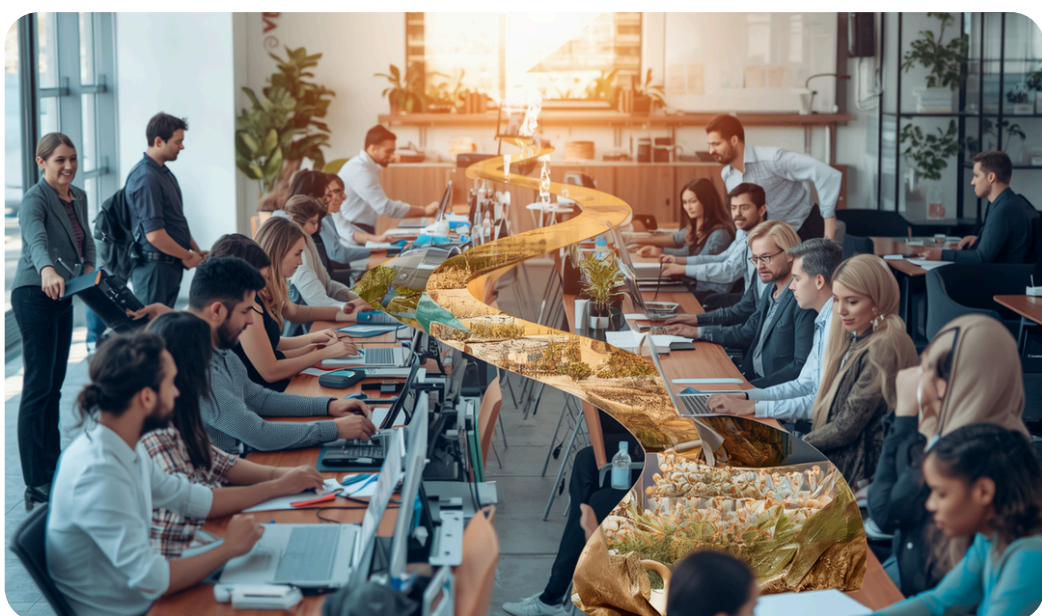
"TRANSFORM Info Days were organised by project partners to present the project to local stakeholders, including local small and medium enterprises, policy-makers, nonprofit organizations, employment centres and other entities working for employment inclusion of vulnerable population and supporting the ecological transition.

These shared moments simultaneously happening in the 7 countries part of TRANSFORM (Italy, Belgium, Germany, Spain, Greece, Cyprus and Serbia) raised awareness about local, regional and global challenges, and what tools is TRANSFORM creating to support these transitions, while offering participants the opportunity to learn more about digital competences and career guidance.

Join TRANSFORM: Two Ways to Get Involved with Us

This month, TRANSFORM is opening two different opportunities to join its learning activities, depending on your profile and needs.

Path 1 is designed for workers, jobseekers, and adults over 25. It offers a 30-hour personalised online learning journey, built around a self-assessment of competences and including modules on energy, agri-food, tourism, digital skills, and entrepreneurship, according to your sector of preference. Participants will also benefit from certification for each completed module and at least one job counselling meeting with local SMEs. Starting on May.



Path 2 is addressed to business owners, HR staff, and SMEs. Through the Smart Skills Intelligence Portal, organisations can register employees, map existing competences, identify skills gaps, and access free suggested training opportunities. The pathway also includes an asynchronous expert session and a hybrid workshop on professional orientation, transferable skills, workforce resilience, and adaptability. Starting in June. Choose the path that fits you best and become part of the TRANSFORM learning community!
